At present planning is taking place to have breakfasts included for three mornings and lunches for the two full days of the seminar. Dinners will **not** be included with accommodations, and participants are thus free (and warmly encouraged) to explore any of a number of excellent restaurants, bistros and cafes. Otherwise, the hotel has its own restaurant and room service.

The seminar will take place in a meeting room within the same hotel, which can be especially convenient for avoiding long walks to campus on what are bound to be very steamy and hazy days, but also to have ready access to one's room should one feel ill.

**Location:**



The Hotel is located one short block from two large shopping malls, the Forum Pepsi (with restaurants, cinemas, etc.) and across the street from the Forum, Place Alexis-Nihon (a much larger mall, with the range of shops one usually expects to find). Within Place Alexis-Nihon itself, on the lowest level, is the Metro (subway): the stop here is **Atwater**, which is on the **Green line** (see: <http://www.stcum.qc.ca/English/metro/a-mapmet.htm>).

**Shuttle Schedule**

**L'Aérobis** is the shuttle service from Montréal - Pierre Elliott Trudeau International Airport to the Montréal Central Bus Station (Berri Terminal).
